1 Te Whare Ākongā o Te Akatoki

Named after the toki (adze) that Tāwhaki used in his ascent to the heavens, Te Whare Ākongā o Te Akatoki is the home of the UC Māori Students' Association, and provides a space for ākongā Māori to connect with other Māori students studying at UC.

2 Engineering Precinct

This building has 4 wings: Mechanical, Civil & Natural Resources, Electrical and Computer, Chemical and Process Engineering.

3 Ernest Rutherford

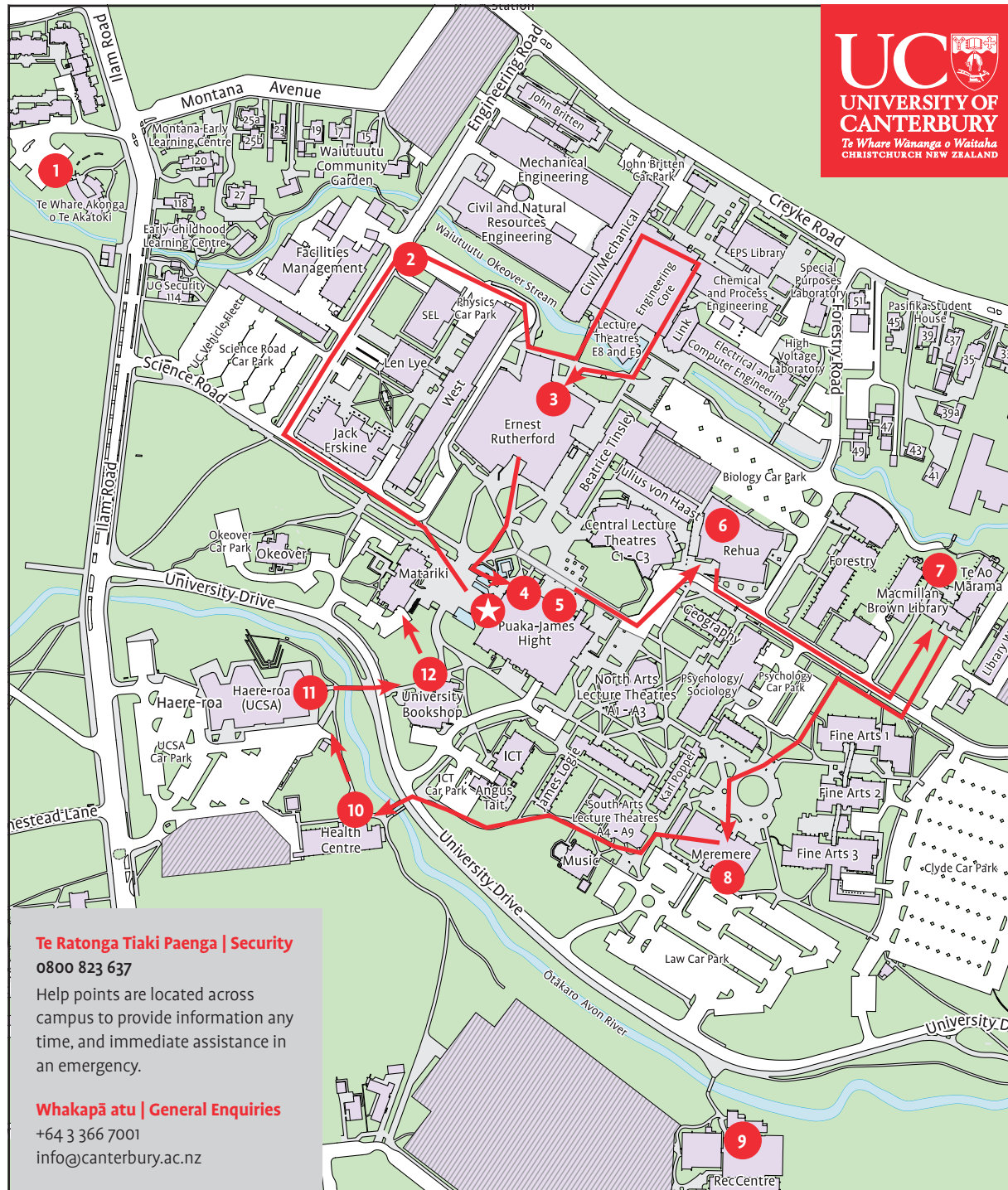

4 Puaka-James Hight

6 Rehua

Rehua is the home of the College of Education, Health and Human Development, the Centre for Entrepreneurship and executive development programmes from the UC Business School.

7 Te Ao Mārama

Te Ao Mārama means the world of enlightenment and is the academic home of mātauranga Māori. This warehouse houses Aotahi – School of Māori and Indigenous Studies, Kā Waimaero | Ngāi Tahu Research Centre and Te Waka Pākāano | Office of the Assistant Vice-Chancellor Māori, Pacific and Equity.

8 Meremere

This building is the centre for Business & Law and hosts a simulated business trading room with a live share market stock ticker. It also has a Moot Room (a mock court room), which was used for real trials by the Canterbury District Court following the Waitaha Canterbury earthquakes.

9 Recreation Centre

This centre includes indoor squash and basketball courts, rock climbing, fitness classes and a gym. The gym is free for all students.

10 Whare Hauora Health Centre

The centre has doctors, nurses and other health specialists. Most doctors' appointments are free to students.

11 Haere-roa

This is a space for students to socialise, enjoy amazing events and engage with clubs. This building includes the Ngaio Marsh Theatre, Bentley's Lounge, The Foundry student bar, club facilities and UCSA.

12 University Bookshop

The bookshop has a range of books, gifts, UC merchandise and guarantees to provide all recommended texts for UC courses.
