Find out more about UC Scholarships

How to use this brochure:

1. Look for the scholarships you could be eligible for (pages 3–6). Some scholarships are only available to international students, or to students who are enrolled at UC in particular subjects or degrees.
2. Check for closing dates. You must submit your application online by the closing date, otherwise your application will not be considered.
3. Check the value of the scholarship (pages 3–6). Some scholarships are worth more than others, and some may be given over a number of years. Some scholarships cover only your first-year tuition fees at UC.
4. Make sure you understand the key terms used (see table below).
5. Check if your preferred hall of residence offers a scholarship (page 7).
6. If you need help, talk to the Scholarships Office.

How do I find out about scholarships?

UC offers about \$24.4 million in scholarships and prizes each year. In this brochure you will find many scholarships for those who are starting study in 2018. There are many more available and new scholarships are established regularly, make sure that you search for all that you could be eligible for at www.canterbury.ac.nz/scholarships/

Other organisations also offer scholarships that UC students can apply for. Check with your school or local community groups for further information.

How do I know if I am eligible for a scholarship?

Each scholarship has different eligibility criteria (e.g. subject/course, level, citizenship, age, gender, ethnicity, school, region, etc).

Check the regulations to see if you meet the criteria. Apply for all the scholarships you are eligible for, as it is possible to hold more than one scholarship each year.

What if I am going on a gap year?

If you are planning to go overseas on a gap year, you should check whether the scholarship application must be submitted before you depart.

How do I apply for a scholarship?

Students will apply through the UC Scholarships website. Applications can be submitted online from 20 June 2017. The closing date for applications is **15 August 2017**.

To submit a scholarship application online, students will first need to register for a myUC account.

Referees will also be invited by the student to submit their references through the online system.

Note: Many scholarships have selection criteria which are also listed in the regulations – be aware of this when completing application forms.

Glossary

Award	General term for an amount of money given out to a student.
Bursary	A financial award conferred primarily, but not exclusively, on the basis of financial need.
First year fees	Tuition fees and compulsory fees (includes the student services levy).
First year tuition fees	The tuition fees for the year, which is calculated from the fee for each course a student is enrolled in.
First year undergraduate student	A student starting the first year of their undergraduate degree, and who has not enrolled at another tertiary institution since finishing secondary school.
Gap Year	A period, between the end of a former student's last school year and the beginning of an academic year of the university, spent by the former student in non-academic activities. Considered to be of no more than 12 months' duration.
International student	A student who is not a NZ citizen or holder of a NZ residence class visa.
Regulations	The rules governing an award, scholarship, or bursary.
Scholarship	General term for an amount of money given out to a student.


