

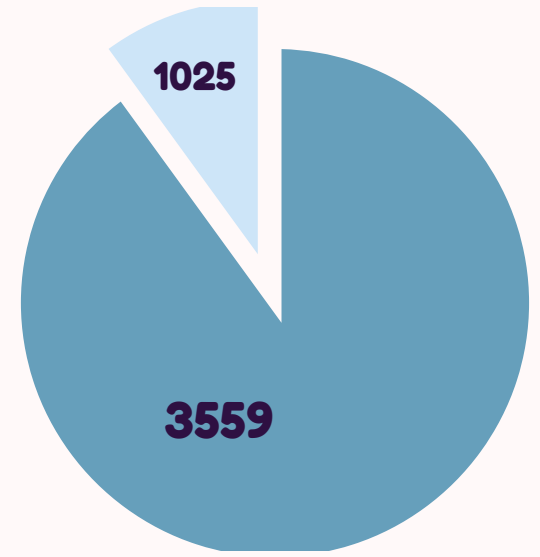

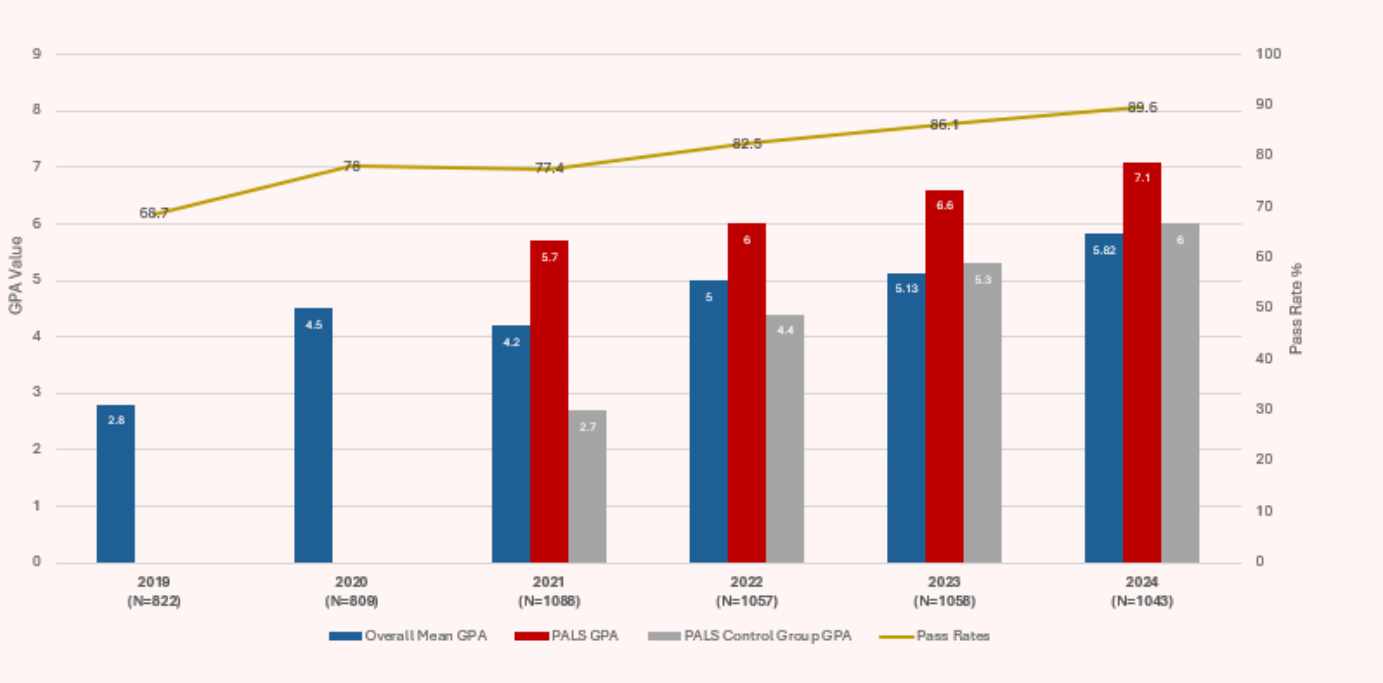

29% of eligible students attended at least 1 session

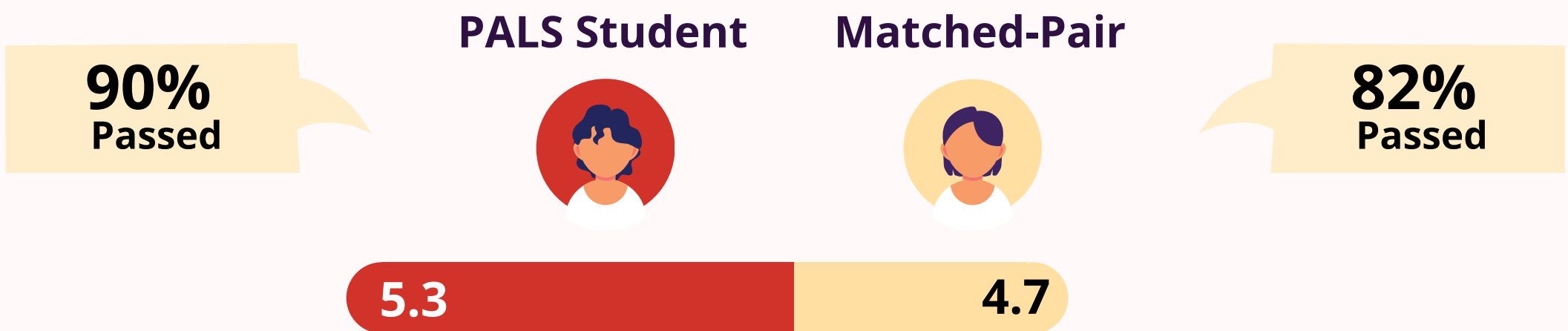
MOMENTUM: COURSE REDESIGN



PSYC105 GPA Outcomes

- Increased Pass Rate since PALS Introduction + Course Redesign in 2021
- Ongoing work and establishment of PALS are contributing to continuous GPA improvement

PALS students were found to have a statistically higher mean course GPA when compared to a control group of matched-pair students



*Statistically significant at $\alpha = 0.05$

Matched-Pair Analysis: Matched on Age, Ethnicity Priority, Fresher Derivation, First in Whānau, Gender, Programme, Disability, and Socio-Economic Status
